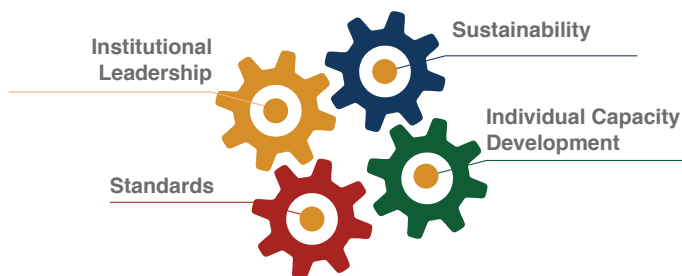


Research Management Programme in Africa (ReMPRO Africa)



The Research Management in Africa Programme addresses four interconnected strands:

- 1 Institutional Leadership** – ensuring sufficient awareness and engagement, and hence continuity of support for strengthening research management functions across successive generations of institutional leadership and senior academic staff.
- 2 Sustainability** – Sustainable research management function in African institutions, including financial and career sustainability. Institutions finding mechanisms to ensure that they can support their own research management functions, regardless of funder or government support; and aligning funder policies towards meeting indirect costs.
- 3 Standards** – reaching an understanding on common standards and good practice that constitute an acceptable level of provision, recognised both by institutions and funding partners.
- 4 Developing Individual Capacity of research management staff** – established for individuals in key research management functions to promote the notion of the research management ‘career’ pathway in institutions, supported by an appropriate infrastructure of networks and training opportunities.
